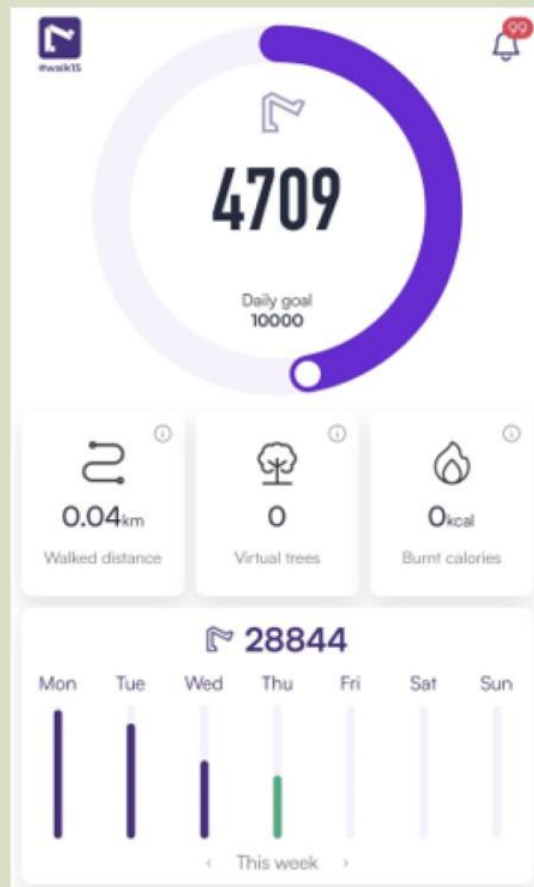
#Walk15

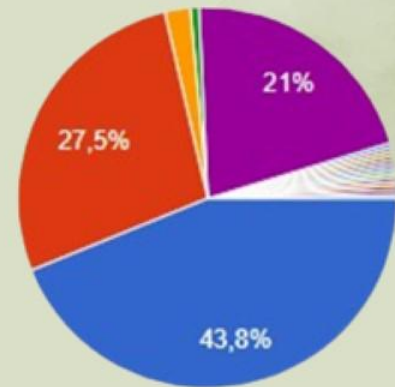

Survey analysis of transportation in S.Šalkauskis gymnasium
