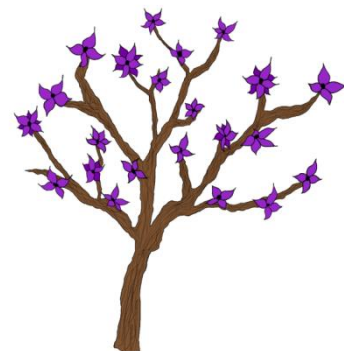


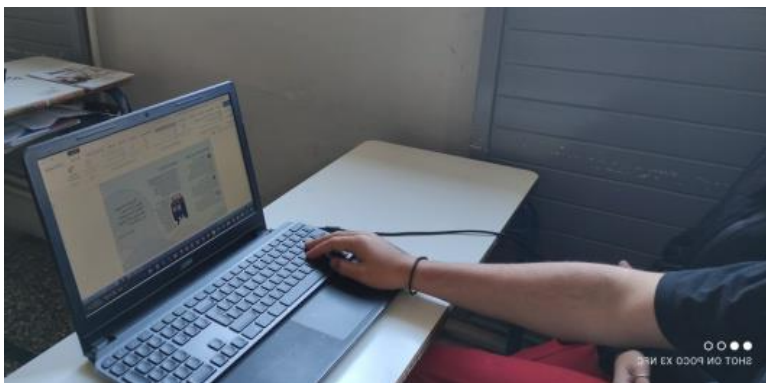
## WORK DONE AFTER THE MEETING IN ITALY (Before Lithuanian meeting)

We made debates at school and students of A and B grade wrote articles explaining and justifying a responsible recycling creating instead of littering and proposing powerful ways to help the environment. That was done initially by understanding Recycling Basics through learning in greek and foreign language classes by using school books and net information. **We went outside and saw** separate recyclables (paper, plastic,



metal, glass) from trash, if it worked properly. We know that local recycling guidelines rules can vary by region. We learned that rinsing off food or drink residue before recycling helps prevent contamination, ensuring the materials can be processed effectively. During our classes we gathered information and informed other students about responsible recycling practices, proper waste disposal, and the environmental impact of littering. What should be done.



We promised to participate in community cleanup events, recycling drives, or workshops to raise awareness and help keep your environment clean. We decided to make a campaign and talk to neighbor schools. By taking actions together we can reduce waste, recycle responsibly, and get creative with reusing materials—helping to prevent littering and contributing to a more sustainable future.
