

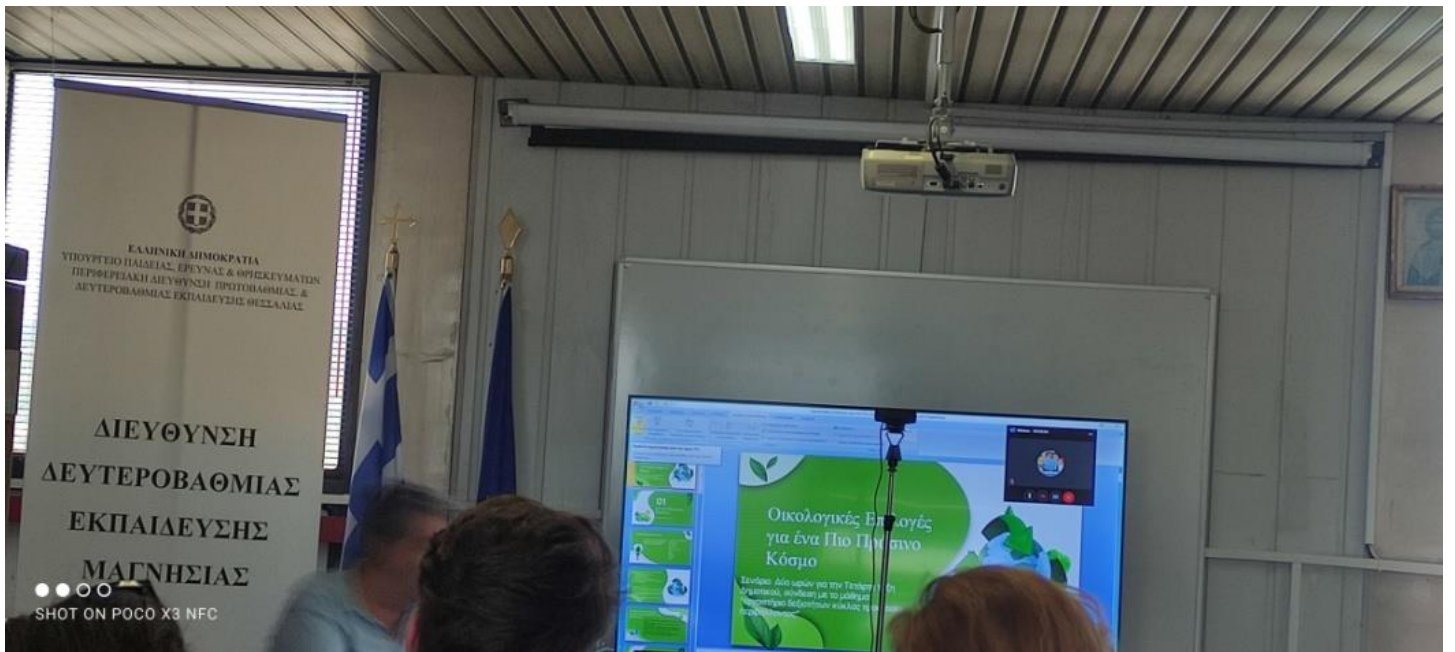
WORK DONE AFTER THE MEETING IN TURKIYE (BEFORE ROMANIAN)
