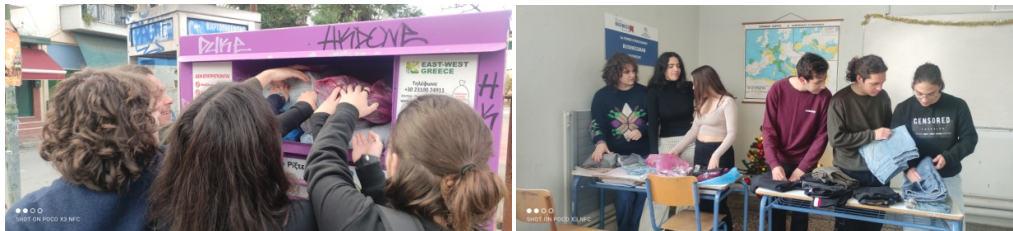


## Work done after the meeting in Romania before the meeting in Italy

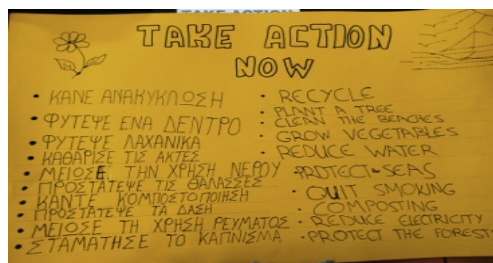
Urban designs , focus on public transport, cycling, and walkability, Reducing emissions in air travel are some of the issues we were taught.
